Proposed Parish Boundaries

6. St Joseph, Todmorden

From Hoof Stones Height on the Lancashire - Yorkshire boundary, by a beeline to and along Noah Dale Water and Colden Water to the River Calder. Upstream by the River Calder to its confluence with Stoodley Clough and by this clough to and along the ancient boundary to Turvin Clough then upstream to a stream junction and by a beeline across the middle of White Holme Reservoir to the Lancashire and Yorkshire boundary and by this boundary to Hoof Stones Height.

Comment

In line with a 1914 agreement between the Leeds and Salford dioceses, the boundaries of St Joseph's would be those of the Borough of Todmorden as incorporated in 1896, or after its dissolution in 1974, the boundaries of today's Todmorden Town Council.
